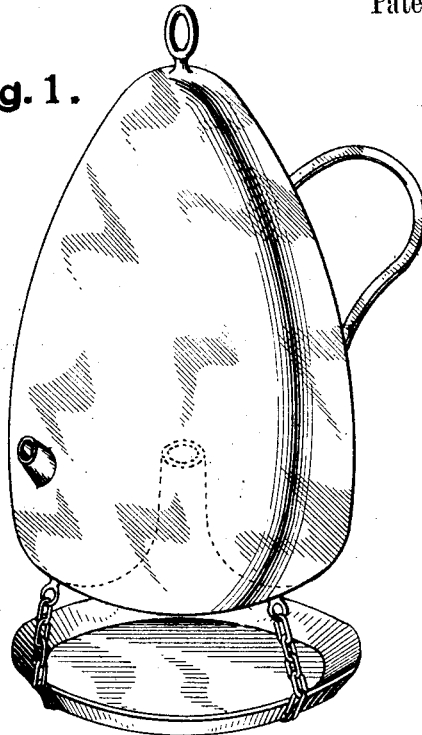
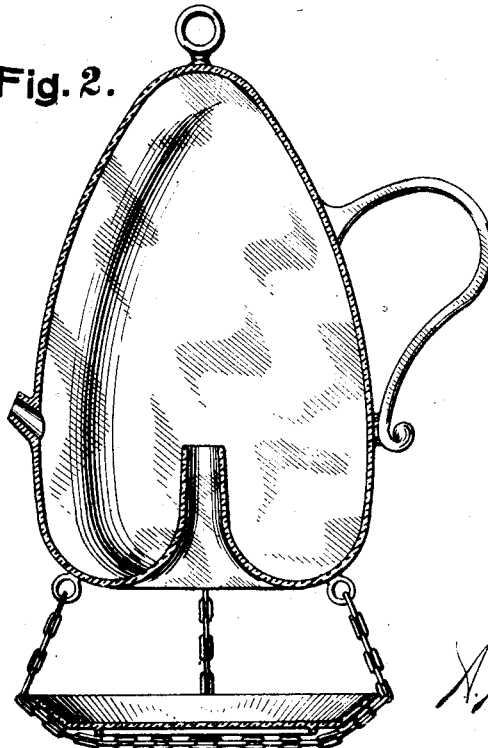

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ILARION WLAJKO, a subject of the Emperor of Austria, residing at Forbes Road, in the county of Westmoreland and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fly-Trap, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a view in perspective of a fly trap, showing my new design, and,

Fig. 2 is a central longitudinal sectional view of the same.
